## Suggestions & Ideas:

Social Media Account	Imagine an Instagram or Twitter account for your juror. What does it look like? What do they post about? What hashtags do they use? Consider using a template to create a social media page; if you're using Instagram, make sure to spotlight one of their posts.
Pre- or Post-Trial Interview	Develop a short script (~2 pages) that captures a pre- or post-trial interview. This can be the <i>voire dire</i> interview (jury selection) or a media interview after the not guilty verdict. Video record the interview – don't forget to be in character!
Book Jacket	Your juror is a famous author. They may have written a memoir, a mystery/thriller, or a steamy romance. Decide what kind of book they wrote and then create the cover using images and text, as well as a brief description of what the book is about. Don't forget to include the author bio – and picture!
Text Message Trail	Give us a glimpse into your juror's social life by creating a text message trail between your juror and another person. Who are they texting, and what are they texting about? They could be texting another juror, a friend, or someone else they are connected to.
Dating Profile	Design a dating profile for your juror. How do they describe themselves when trying to woo a potential partner? Are they lying on their dating profile? What are their likes and dislikes? What are they looking for in a partner? Make sure to include a picture!
Character Playlist	Your character has a playlist they listen to every day. What platform do they use to listen to music? What songs are on the playlist? Which ones do they listen to over and over again? Make sure your juror leaves a comment on a couple songs!

## Reflection:

When you complete this assignment, you will write a 200-word reflection about your work. This reflection must include a note about how your thoughts have developed or changed about the play or your selected juror after having completed the project, and can also include your thoughts about the process, details about why you chose the project you did, or final thoughts about the character.

Finally, add a few words about what you would change about this project if you were to do it again. How can it be improved? Were there parts that didn't work for you? What was missing?
